PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

The application form and prospectus may be obtained from the school office with the following particulars:

- Name of the candidate
- Name of the school last studied
- Class to which admission is sought
- Date of birth
- Occupation of parent
- Permanent address and address for communication

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS

The filled-in application forms should reach the school office for registration within 15 days from issuance.

INSTRUCTION FOR FILLING UP THE APPLICATION FORM

- The application form has to be signed only by one of the parents. In unavoidable cases, the guardian shall sign the application.
- Full permanent address / residential address must be shown clearly.
- Parent's occupation and office address also be furnished.
- The details furnished in the filled in application form should be correct in all aspects. Any discrepancy or supply of false information may lead rejection of the application.
- Father's and mother's full name should be written without any spelling error.

SCHOOL ACADEMIC SESSION

The school academic session for all grades from KG to XII will be from April to March but, the month of May will be declared as summer vacation. The school will function on all working days except Sundays and public holidays.

SCHOOL TIMETABLE

(Students are requested to fill in)

ATTENDANCE

- 1. Students should attend the school regularly.
- 2. No extra classes will be conducted for students who avail leave.
- 3. Any student who is absent to the class shall submit leave letter to the class teacher.
- 4. Prior permission shall be obtained for any long leave.
- 5. Absent for periodical assessment / terminal examinations will not be entertained at any ground except illness certified by a doctor.
- The students must attend the morning assembly and prayers and the late comers shall report to the principal / teacher designated and get noted in the students' handbook. Routine late coming will be viewed seriously.
- 7. The students with ill health / contagious diseases will not be permitted to attend the classes.

WITHDRAWAL AND DISMISSAL

- Applications for the withdrawal of a pupil should be submitted in writing to the Principal at least a month before the date of withdrawal or a month's fee will be charged in lieu of the notice.
- 2. A transfer certificate or any other certificates will be issued only if the school dues are paid and library books or any other school belongings taken on loan are returned.
- Irregular attendance, habitual ill-health, disobedience or defiance of authority, malpractice in examinations, lack of improvement in conduct and studies even after warnings or found detrimental to the moral tone of the school are the sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a student.

BOOKS AND NOTEBOOKS

Books and notebooks will be supplied by the school on the prescribed payment. To maintain uniformity and quality, the students are advised to buy their study materials from the school only.

CO-CURRICULAR / EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

CO-SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

In order to ensure that the students develop a sense of responsibility and leadership quality and also to explore their innate talents, potentials and qualities, the school provides ample opportunities through a wide variety of co-curricular activities.

The following activities will be assessed under co-scholastic activities and graded on a 5-point scale (A - E) for all the classes.

SCHOOL HOUSE SYSTEM

- The school follows House System to group the staff and all the students into four houses as Blue, Green, Red and Yellow.
- Each House has Guide staff, Students Captain, Vice-Captain and a group of students who help in the maintenance and layout of the House.
- There should be a healthy competitive spirit among the houses to excel in studies, games, athletics and other cocurricular activities.

SCHOOL CLUBS

The school has installed various Clubs, namely, Tamil Club, English Club, Hindi Club, Math Club, Science Club, Fine Arts Club and Computer Club in order to bring out the natural, built-in talents of every student through various events. The clubs conduct subject enrichment programs in regular intervals.

EDUCATIONAL TOUR / PICNICS

School organizes educational trips and tours to explore the world outside the classrooms. Travelling is a delightful experience, which keeps the students in tune with the mysteries of nature and life styles of different people. It broadens their horizon and enriches their education.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The school also offers training on Instrumental Music, Taekwondo, Skating, Silambam, Classical Dance, Abacus, Chess, Yoga and French as extra-curricular activities at nominal fees in order to enrich every student with added skills.

THE STUDENT COUNCIL

The student council has been established to assist the Principal and the staff in the smooth functioning of the school. The council consists of the school leader, the general secretary, the House Captains and the Vice Captains. These office bearers play a vital role in maintaining discipline and order. All students are answerable to the office bearers for their conduct in the school.

STAFF COUNCIL

The school has the following staff councils:

- The Academic Council aims to maintain high academic standards by introducing the most effective techniques of teaching, raising the standard of slow learning students, organizing various curricular activities like Seminars, Group discussions, Symposiums etc.
- The Cultural Council is in charge of organizing various school functions like Club Inauguration Day, Independence Day, Teacher's Day, School Feast, Children's Day, Christmas Day, Pongal Day, Annual Day etc. and for conducting film shows and other recreational activities of the pupils.
- The Sports Council is in charge of organizing the Annual Sports meet, Inter-House matches and other activities in the school. It is also responsible for organizing morning assembly, maintaining discipline and cleanliness of the students.

SPORTS AND GAMES

Sports and games are given due importance in the school. All the major indoor and outdoor games are offered to the students. The Sports Club encourages all round development of the students and organizes a number of inter school competitions.

LIBRARY REGULATIONS

- All pupils and staff are the members of the library.
- Only one book will be issued at a time and the pupil can retain it for a maximum of one week. The book borrowed by the pupil shall be returned without any damage caused to the book.
- Reference books cannot be taken out of the library.
- Readers should not write / damage / any book, manuscript or magazine belonging to the library.
- Readers shall be responsible for any damage done to the books or other property belonging to the library and shall be required to replace each book or the property damaged or pay the said value in cash thereof.
- Readers will be allowed to take only the school handbook
 & ID cards into the library.
- Before leaving the library, the student is accountable to satisfy the librarian as to whether the books lent to him / her are in good condition. Otherwise, he / she is responsible for the replacement of the book.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT (IF AVAILED)

School Vans / buses are made available for students. Parents shall make necessary arrangements to handover their children at appointed time to avoid delay in picking up their children at the scheduled time and spots.

TRANSPORT RULES

'It is better to be on the safer side'

- Students who avail the bus facilities are to utilize for the whole year.
- Parents should stick to the pickup points throughout the year.
- Giving tips to the driver/conductor is prohibited.
- The students are not permitted to reserve seats for themselves or for their friends.
- Students should obey the instructions and follow the guidance of the bus crew.
- Unruly behavior and undisciplined act of the students inside the bus will lead to disciplinary action against them, and eventually, the transportation facility will be cancelled for the miscreants.
- The bus conductor and the teacher in-charge must be informed beforehand if the student uses his / her private transport or taken by the parent from the school.
- The fee receipts must be kept under safe custody and the same must be produced if required by the school.
- The students must clear the transport fee arrears before academic exams.

NOTE TO STUDENTS

The students

- 1. shall give due respect to all the teachers in the school.
- 2. shall stand and wish a teacher or a visitor when he/she enters and leaves the classroom.
- 3. shall not interfere when the teachers are conversing.
- 4. shall observe complete silence in the absence of any teacher.
- 5. shall not whisper to disturb the classes and shall not talk loudly on the corridors and also stop conversing when teachers or superiors pass by.
- 6. shall read the handbook carefully; adhere with the norms and take note on the important things.
- 7. shall not use any bad language, unruly behavior and manners against any student or teacher.
- 8. shall not drive motor vehicles as per the rules of the govt. The school expects strict observance of the same.
- 9. should converse only in English; from KG to Grade XII.
- 10. shall have faith and fear of God and believe that praying to the God for any help is answered.
- 11. shall consider time is precious and use it responsibly.
- 12. shall report to the school in time and maintain neat and tidy full school uniform as prescribed.
- 13. shall maintain the notebooks and homework neatly and the same shall be completed promptly. The works done must be corrected by the concerned teachers consistently. Students are advised to use only ink pen from standard IV onwards.

- 14. shall refrain from damaging school's properties, compensation must be paid against any such damages (if caused), at the discretion of the principal.
- 15. shall ensure that the bicycle is locked properly before leaving to their respective classes if they come to school by bicycle. The school will not be held responsible for the cycle that is lost.
- 16. shall be aware that the promotion to the higher class is entirely depending on the academic performance of the students.
- 17. shall bring napkins / hand-towels, spoons in order to maintain classrooms neat and tidy.
- 18. shall not bring story books, magazines and periodicals to the classrooms without being approved by the Principal.
- 19. shall not keep money with them. If money is brought, it should be deposited at the school office.
- 20. shall be responsible for their belongings. While every effort is taken by the school authorities to avoid the loss of such articles, the ultimate responsibility rests on students only.
- 21. shall be responsible for your own books, fountain pen, tiffin and lunch careers, etc.
- 22. shall keep the surroundings clean and any student who makes the place dirty or encourages for the same will be viewed seriously.
- 23. shall refrain from attending the school if suffering from contagious diseases will not be permitted to attend the classes.
- 24. shall submit the leave letter to the class teacher when he / she joins the school after the leave.

- 25. shall avail long leave only after obtaining the prior permission from the Principal.
- 26. shall attach a medical certificate along with the leave letter, if availing leave for more than 5 days on medical grounds. If a student is absent for more than a month without intimation, his / her name will be struck off from the roll.
- 27. shall not avail private tuition with their teachers without the permission of the Principal.
- 28. shall get prior permission to meet the teachers at their residence / quarters / rooms.
- 29. shall not leave the classroom without teacher's permission.
- 30. shall leave the school with the permission of the Principal in case of falling sick.
- 31. shall/will be sent out if found guilty in copying or attempting to copy during the examination.
- 32. shall take part in the activities of the school's sports and games unless certified physically unfit by a doctor.
- 33. shall take part in games and recreation which will refresh the mind and give you energy for study.
- 34. shall be aware that, any damage to the school's property, disfiguring the walls, damaging of furniture and electrical appliances, use of nick names, use of unparliamentarily words, use of filthy language or any other form of misconducts are punishable offences.
- 35. shall be aware that, smoking, use of drugs, narcotics, intoxicants, chewing betel nuts, chewing gums, pan-parag, etc., are strictly prohibited inside the campus and any such activity will result in immediate dismissal.

- 36. shall have the accepted hairstyle (Boys short hair, properly combed, not to strengthen hair with petroleum jelly, No beard and moustache either).
- 37. shall have decent dressing Avoid low hip dressing and pants sweeping the floor and tight fitting garments.
- 38. shall be aware that, the causes that justify the removal of a student on the part of the school authorities are: offences against honesty and morality and habitual insubordination.

NOTE TO THE PARENTS

Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities by enforcing regularity and discipline, by seeing to it that the children prepare their lessons and by taking an active interest in the activities of the school.

- 1. Students should report to the school on the day of reopening.
- 2. Permission should be sought in case of any late reporting.
- 3. Parents should stitch/ attach identification tag in all the belongings of their ward.
- 4. Parents / Guardians are not permitted to visit their ward during the school hours.
- 5. In case of emergency only the parents or the guardians are permitted to meet their wards with the permission of the Principal, and not his/her associates.
- Parents shall contact their ward through the given Mobile Number. Students are not allowed to have mobile phone and if it is found in possession, it will be confiscated and a fine will be levied on the student.
- 7. E-mail facility also is available in the school office, parents intending to use it may make use of the E-mail address.

- 8. All communications to the school should be made only through the principal.
- 9. Parents cannot have direct contact with the teachers, except through the principal.
- 10. Parents are requested not to visit the teacher's residence and contact them over telephone.
- 11. Parents should meet all the teachers during the parentsteachers contact session on every second Friday afternoon between 2.00 pm & 3.30 pm or as it is noted in the handbook.
- 12. Parents should observe the academic performance of their wards. During parents - teachers contact session the parents are requested to meet the teachers with their ward & handbook to discuss the steps to be taken for the progress of the child.
- 13. Parents should ask for the handbook of their ward and should acknowledge the same.
- 14. The progress record is based on his/her overall performance and not on the studies alone.
- 15. A cumulative record is maintained in the school for each student. Parents are requested to ask for cumulative record of the ward from the class teacher and acknowledge the same.
- 16. Annual fee has to be paid before the stipulated time. Parents desirous to pay the fee in 2 installments can do so with an additional fee Rs.1,000/- along with the second installment. Cheque will not be accepted at any cost.
- 17. When a student is admitted in the school, the parents/ guardians will be deemed to have gone through and accepted all these rules and regulations of the school.

- 18. Make your wards participate in any one of the Educational Tours which will be arranged by the management.
- 19. The school authorities may modify the terms and conditions mentioned in the prospectus from time to time without prior notice.
- 20. Students shall avoid availing leave for the following reasons:
 - a) Family function; not for blood relatives
 - b) Accompanying parents on tour
 - c) Simple religious ceremonies
 - e) Attending to / entertaining relatives / visitors at home.

RESOLUTION ON DISCIPLINE

- 4. Pupils, who reach the school campus early, should enter their classroom and engage themselves in silent study.
- At the first bell, both students and staff shall assemble in the courtyard of the class in order. On dispersal, the students should move to their own classrooms in perfect order, together with their class teacher at the rear of the line.
- 6. When the teacher enters the classroom, all the students

- should stand up, greet the teachers and should thank the teacher when the class is over.
- Students shall not leave their classroom during or in between the periods and they shall not enter any other classroom.
- 8. Lost articles must be claimed from the school office within a week, after which period unclaimed articles will be disposed of.
- 9. Any damage caused to the property of the school must be immediately reported to the Principal.
- 10. All waste papers must be put in the proper receptacle.
- 11. Selling or buying of anything among the students on the school premises is strictly prohibited.
- 12. Parents are earnestly requested not to provide any personal gifts to staff.

GENERAL INFORMATION

FOR THE KIND ATTENTION OF THE PARENTS HEALTHY EATING FOR YOUR GROWING CHILD

When your child first starts going to school, he or she will start growing quickly and becoming more active. Children's energy and nutrient needs are high. So it's important that they get a healthy balanced diet containing plenty of fruits, vegetables and starchy foods.

VEGETARIAN DIET FOR CHILDREN

If you want to give your child a vegetarian diet, it's important to make sure their diet is balanced.

GETTING ENOUGH PROTEIN

Pulses (Lentils and beans), milk, cheese and eggs are rich sources of protein.

GETTING ENOUGH IRON

Good sources of iron include:

- Wholegrain cereals, leafy green vegetables such as spinach and watercress, pulses, dried apricots or figs.
- Remember, eating food containing Vitamin C with iron-rich food, might make it easier to absorb iron from our food.
- Also avoid giving your child too much tea or coffee because it could reduce the amount of iron they can absorb.

MINERALS AND VITAMINS

Milk, cheese, yoghurt, soya beans and nuts are rich in calcium, which is needed for healthy bones and teeth. Citrus fruit, tomatoes and potatoes are all good sources of Vitamin C.

NON-VEGETARIAN DIET

- Cereals and oily fish these foods are good sources of dietary vitamin D, which helps to keep bones healthy.
- Meat (particularly red meat), which is a rich source of iron

 fish, pulses, green vegetables and cereals are also good sources of iron.
- At least two portions of fish a week you can give boys up to four portions of oily fish a week, but it's best to give girls no more than two portions.

FOOD TO LIMIT

There are certain foods, such as junk foods and drinks that can be harmful to your child's health, if they have them too much or too often.

SWEETS AND SNACKS

- Eating sweet and sticky foods frequently between meals causes dental decay. Snack food such as cakes, biscuits, chocolate and sweets can be high in sugar and saturated fat, and low in certain vitamins and minerals.
- Make sure they eat them only occasionally or in smaller amount, so they only make up a relatively small part of the overall diet.

- Help and encourage your child to clean their teeth twice every day – once in the morning and before going to bed at night.
- Check the label and choose those options lower in fat, saturated in fat, sugar and salt.

DRINKS

Sweet drinks damage teeth, especially if drunk frequently or sipped from a bottle over long periods between meals. So try to keep drinks such as fruit juice or squash to meal times, and try to encourage your child to drink water or milk in between.

SALT

There is no need to add much of salt to your child's food. The maximum amount of salt your child should have depends on their age. As a guide:

- Four to six years 3g a day
- Seven to ten years- 5g a day
- 11 years onwards 6g a day

If you're buying processed food, even those aimed at children, remember to check the information given on the labels to choose those with less salt.

HEALTHY WEIGHT

If you encourage your child to eat a healthy balanced diet with only small amount of food containing sugar and fat, and get plenty of physical activity, they should maintain a healthy weight.

PARENTAL HELP FOR THE ACADEMIC IMPROVEMENT OF THE CHILDREN

- Checking homework, attending school meetings and events, discussing school activities at home will have a more powerful influence on students' academic performance than anything about the school the students attend.
- The effort put-forth by parents (reading stories aloud, meeting with teachers etc.) has a bigger impact on their children's educational achievement than the effort expended by either teachers or the students themselves.
- Limit children's screen time (including TV, mobiles and computer games) to less than two hours a day.
- Every achievement of the child however small it may be appreciated.
- When the children do not perform well, use positive suggestions to make progress in the coming examinations than unduly rebuking them or comparing with others.
- Expose the children to good books on Values, General Knowledge, and Scientific facts and encourage them with positive remarks.
